



Quality Inspector

A key element of the job is the rigorous inspection and testing of the product before the release to the operations warehouse and supporting the handover of the parts and components into production. This will be done both at Farleygreene HQ and suppliers manufacturing sites therefore some driving will be required.

Main responsibilities:

- Reading engineering drawings and instructions to comprehend the quality expectation for those materials.
- Inspecting and testing materials to ensure they meet those quality expectations.
- Assist with transporting materials to the relevant suppliers.
- Approve or reject material with respect to quality standards.
- Monitoring and reporting to the relevant people on materials that may affect the machine build process.
- Raising and documenting any non-conformances and recording supplier performance.
- To maintain and check all calibrated equipment within the inspection area.
- Prepare and submit reports to the Quality Manager.
- Assist the Operations Manager with ad-hoc duties.
- Follow and comply with all quality management system requirements.

- A keen eye for detail and a results-driven approach.
- Analytical mindset.
- Knowledge of the Process and/or Engineering industry.
